2020 MEN'S GOLF SCHEDULE

OPENING DAY KICK-OFF

SATURDAY, MAY 2 • 9:00 AM SHOTGUN START

This event is a 2 Best Ball of 4 Shamble. Please sign up for this event individually and a foursome will be created based on handicap (A,B,C,D) for team equality.

PRESIDENT'S CUP MATCH PLAY

SIGN UP BY SUNDAY, MAY 3

The format is individual match play with matches played during the Spring and Summer. There are three divisions this year: President's Division (Blue Tees, handicap index must be less than 10.0), Vice President's Division (White Tees) and Treasurer's Division (Gold Tees, 65 years and older). All matches will be stroked off the low handicap in the group. Please contact the Golf Shop to register. Golfers may elect to play in multiple divisions.

MEN'S TUESDAY NIGHT GOLF LEAGUE

BEGINS TUESDAY, MAY 5 • 5:30 PM SHOTGUN START

Players will sign up individually and team captains will be appointed to select teams. This season's round robin selection party will be held at 6:00 PM on Friday, May 1 in the Clubhouse Lounge. Come out and join us! Every Tuesday, four members of each team will compete to accumulate points for their team in this season long event.

CHOKER TOURNAMENT

SUNDAY, MAY 17 • 8:30 AM TEE TIMES BEGIN

The format is 2 Best Ball of 4 with 1 choker per hole. Choker is a format in which one person on the team has a designated hole that must count towards the team score. Sign up as an individual and the Golf Shop will pair teams based on handicap (A,B,C,D).

TEAM MATCH PLAY

SATURDAY, JUNE 13 • 8:30 AM SHOTGUN START

Players must sign up individually and the Golf Shop will create teams. Partners will play 27 holes, three 9-hole matches consisting of different formats to determine a winner.

MEN'S CHALLENGER

SATURDAY, JUNE 27 • 9:00 AM SHOTGUN START

This **NEW** event is an individual Quota Point format event where the hole locations will be extra challenging. Players quota's will be 36 minus their individual course handicap. As an example, a 10 handicap would receive a quota of 26. Points per hole will be awarded as followed: Bogey 1 point, Par 2 points, Birdie 4 points and Eagle 8 points. The player that earns the most points over his quota will be our winner.

MEN'S OLD PAL

SATURDAY, JULY 11 AND SUNDAY, JULY 12 • 8:30 AM TEE TIMES BEGIN

Players will sign up in teams of two. The format is the combined Net Stableford Points of partners played at 100% of their individual course handicap. Both players' points will be added together to produce their total team score.

MEN'S GUEST INVITATIONAL

THURSDAY, JULY 30 - SATURDAY, AUGUST 1

Member-Guest teams will be grouped by handicap into flights of six and play each team in their flight for one 9-hole match. There is a practice round on Thursday, July 30 with an optional team and skins game. Flight winners will advance to the Invitational Shoot-Out on Saturday afternoon to determine our Overall Champion.

CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP

SATURDAY, AUGUST 29 - SUNDAY, AUGUST 30 • 8:30 AM TEE TIMES BEGIN

Format will be individual stroke play with three divisions:

Gross (Blue Tees), Net (White Tees) and Senior (Gold Tees, 65 years and older).

ONE-MAN SCRAMBLE

SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 12 • 8:30 AM TEE TIMES BEGIN

This individual format gives players two opportunities at every shot. Bad drive, errant iron shot or a missed putt is forgiven because you have a second opportunity to get back on track. Players will receive 50% of their individual course handicap.

Players will compete as two-man team, playing a 6-6-6 rotation where each 6 holes consists of a different format. This is the final event of the Men's season.
