



PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Greetings Members,

I have to admit that preparing these articles becomes more difficult each month. I'd like to think the difficulty in developing the content is because most of what I want to say, you already know. However, my wife has suggested that perhaps the difficulty arises because I'm not as funny as I think I am.

Actually, the main reason it can be difficult each month is because I've been President, off and on again, for almost 6 years. As a result, I have written quite a few "President Messages", and I fear repeating my old stories. To avoid that predicament, I often review the old editions of the Newsletter. In doing so, I realized how much the Club has changed over the past 8 years.

Our many "newer" Members might find it fascinating to know that in the Fall of 2013, when I first became President, we were going through some rough times and our membership had declined to about 185 loyal members. Around that same time, we started our partnership with AVI, which was absolutely critical for the continued viability, and in fact, actual existence of the Club. In 2014, times were so tight, we had to solicit the Members for what was called an "Operational Recovery Payment" so we could meet our year end obligations. Although there were some rough times in the ensuing years, we were able to sustain ourselves as a truly private country club for two main reasons.

First, we owe much of our subsequent success to our friends at AVI. While most successful companies like AVI would have run for the hills, they stuck with us and helped us revamp our food and beverage service. They also continued to invest in the Club and help us recruit, develop and assemble the remarkably capable management staff we all enjoy. We're not quite where we need to be, but compared to 2013, our current successful, vibrant and thriving Club is almost unrecognizable.

The other reason we have become a coruscating Club is because of our Members. Now boasting almost 500 Members, our Members appreciate the changes we've made and have always answered the call to help support the Club, whether it be by using the facilities or helping us financially for one of our many capital improvements like the Vibe, the Breeze or last year's Outdoor Patio enhancement project.

Our Board of Directors is mindful of the contributions made by our Members to help us "refresh" our facilities and has tried earnestly to maintain a consistent dues structure. I'm pleased to report that again this year, our dues will remain low compared to other area private clubs. For those of you who can read between the lines, that was the nice way of saying, "Hey, since we're keeping your dues low, we might need a little help paying for the massive improvement projects with the driving range, cart paths, pool, pool locker rooms, exterior staircases and the extension and enhancements to our Outdoor Patio." If you happen to get a letter in the mail, don't even think about marking it "Return to Sender."

With the appropriate accolades having been conveyed, a few comments are in order regarding the operations of the Club. Our Member dining continues to rise each month, which is either a sign that our food service is second to none or, because of COVID, everyone is absolutely sick of staying home and eating take-out. I'm going with the former since Executive Chef Reggie continues to impress us on a daily basis. The golf course looks fantastic and provides a formidable challenge. Nick and his staff continue to impress us and have the course looking and playing like a PGA tour course. With the Summer season, our tennis courts are in full swing. We hope to add a pickle ball court to provide yet another Member amenity. Finally, we are in full swing at our pool. The recent improvements to the pool and surrounding areas probably should have been done years ago, but the finished product made it worth the wait.



THE HISTORY OF ICE CREAM TRUCKS

Salutations TCC Food Lovers,

Everyone recognizes the tune. It starts faint and gets louder as it approaches, but there is no mistaking it. The famous jingle from the ice cream truck! Kids for decades have been abandoning playgrounds and pick-up ball games at the first sound of the truck. Running to get money from their parents in time to catch the truck as it stopped on your block. Even with changes in food and culture, the ice cream truck has remained present in towns across America, while continuing to serve customers by the same methods started so long ago.

Ice cream vendors started selling street side in the nineteenth century, but the truck itself came a little later. The first ice cream truck is actually credited to a Mahoning Valley Native, Harry Burt of Youngstown, Ohio. He got his start selling scoops of ice cream on a motorized cart fixed with an icebox. He then came up with the idea to place ice cream on a stick and dip it in chocolate. He called it the Good Humor ice cream sucker. This was the product that helped him start the Good Humor Company, widely known for their ice cream snacks. With advancements in technology and sanitation, the truck evolved into what it is today, and what we all remember. The only changes come in the variety of snacks to more popular and relevant characters. For example, in the late 1970s it was a Mickey Mouse pop, now it is a SpongeBob pop.

It is nice to see that some traditions and memories stand the test of time. I bet that almost everyone has a memory of buying from an ice cream truck on a hot Summer day. It was like a treat that popped up spur of the moment. And being that the treat was ice cream, every child remembers it. We offer a few of these treats in Breeze, and just the sight of them brings back fond memories for me. Next time you're out by the Swimming Pool, grab a little piece of your past and take a walk down memory lane!

A great example is this year's Men's Guest Invitational where in the past we have struggled to fill a field of 48; this year we have maxed out the field with 60 teams. I want to sincerely thank every one of our golf Members for your continued support and participation in our golf programs and events.

As we approach late July and early August, our plan is to open the new driving range tee when Nick and our TCC grounds team feel the root structure is healthy enough to support activity. When using our new driving range turf, it is now more important than ever that we follow a few rules to conserve turf and protect the practice facility for the well-being of all Members. Please review the following rules:

Golf cart traffic is not permitted on the new practice tee Shots are only to be struck from within the roped boundaries Divot patterns should be in a straight line with a little grass in-between (See picture from usda.org below)



In addition to preserving the range, let's continue to do our part to fix divots, rake bunkers and repair two ball marks per hole (yours and one other). Thank you for continuing to take pride in maintaining our golf course and helping to distinguish it as the most pristine-conditioned course in the Valley!

THROUGH THE GREEN

Good Day TCC Members,

Fourth of July is an important date in the Golf industry as it marks the midway point of the season. All the maintenance team's hard work should be reflecting in the course's playing condition. The "Dog Days" of Summer are now ahead, and the difficult stretch of maintaining turf begins. You may have noticed that on hot days we will run water on Fairways in the afternoon for three-minute cycles. This is done to cool the turf canopy and prevent permanent turf damage. With an older irrigation system, we sometimes have sprinklers stick leading to a temporary wet spot. We want to apologize in advance as this is a common occurrence.

We are now just weeks away from opening the new Driving Range Tee at TCC. Mother Nature had thrown many curveballs throughout the season, so I want to thank you all for your patience regarding this project. - First Violation A Club representative will provide a verbal warning and explanation of the Club policy to the Primary Member.
- Second Violation Use of the violating Member's personal golf cart will be revoked for the remainder of the season on Club grounds.
- Third Violation One (1) month suspension of all Club privileges.
- Fourth Violation Suspension of all Club privileges for the remainder of the Club year.

In addition to the above, bike riding, walking and jogging on the golf course is permitted prior to 8:00 AM and after 8:00 PM only and is reserved solely for the cart paths.

TRUMBULL COUNTRY CLUB DRESS CODE

As a friendly reminder, all Members and guests are required to adhere to Trumbull Country Club's Dress Code when at the Club. Thank you for your compliance.

1. CLUBHOUSE ATTIRE

Hats and caps are not to be worn in the Clubhouse at any time. Shirts are always to be tucked in under trousers, except for shirts (such as tropical shirts) designed to be worn outside of the trousers. Clothing that has excessive rips, tears and wrinkles or stains is improper attire.

2. GOLF ATTIRE FOR MEN

Golfers shall wear appropriate footwear. Proper golf attire includes any clothing specifically designed for golf and similar to products sold in the Golf Shop. Tennis or jogging shorts, or denim pants or shorts (including jeans) are not permitted. Shirts: mock turtlenecks are permitted. Hats: Hats must be worn bill forward. Shorts: Shorts shall be kept neat and pressed at all times and must be in good taste. String-tied or elastic support wear, such as basketball apparel, is not permitted. Any questionable golf attire is at the discretion of the Golf Pro.

3. GOLF ATTIRE FOR WOMEN

Proper golf attire includes any clothing specifically designed for golf and similar to products sold in the Golf Shop. Golf dresses, skirts/skorts, slacks, shorts, collared shirts and blouses are considered appropriate attire. All sleeveless attire must include a collar.

4. SOCIAL ATTIRE

Dining and social events at the Club vary in format and sometimes the attire will be specified. If not specified, male Members and guests shall wear collared shirts, sweaters, turtlenecks or mock turtlenecks. Tee shirts, jogging suits and sweat-suits are not proper attire for men. No bare feet. Sandals are acceptable. Golf shorts and denim pants (including blue jeans) are permitted unless otherwise specified. If not specified, female Members and guests shall wear skirts or slacks. If attire is specified for an event, please observe the specified dress code, and inform your guests of the stipulated attire. For example, there are different styles of attire that are appropriate and will be announced for the occasion: For certain events formal dress may be specified as jacket required, jacket and tie suggested, etc.

5. POOL ATTIRE

Pool attire is strictly limited to Breeze, the Swimming Pool area and the Swimming Pool locker room facilities and is not acceptable in any other area of the Club grounds, including the Clubhouse and Clubhouse Locker Rooms. Appropriate cover ups and/or tee shirts must be worn into the locker rooms and in the parking lot. This attire is unacceptable in any other area of the Main Clubhouse or Club grounds.

6. TENNIS ATTIRE

Tennis attire and proper shoes are required for juniors and adults to use the tennis courts. Proper tennis attire includes any clothing specifically designed for tennis and sold at Tennis Pro Shops or Sporting Goods stores.
